Abstract: James Baird created this notebook as a child when he visited the Museum. He collected and documented materials about Museum events and programs that he was directly involved in including the Junior Museum Council from 1940 until 1942.

Acquisition Information

Provenance: The notebook was made by James Baird as a child between 1939 and 1942. He gifted the notebook to the Museum in either November or December 2005.

Gift: Gift of James Baird, 2005.

Background Information

Historical Note: As a child between 1939 and 1942, James Baird collected papers and letters related to the activities he was involved with at the Museum when it was located at 60 Burroughs Street, Jamaica Plain.

Collection Information

Scope and Content: The James Baird Notebook consists of various letters and materials from the Museum, documenting James Baird's experiences as a child visiting the Museum and partaking in the Museum's activities. The notebook, titled by Baird as "Museum Notebook," captures his participation in the Museum Junior Council and other events and programs at the Museum between 1939 and 1942.

The Museum papers and James's inscriptions focus on the formation of the Museum Council which consisted of museum staff and the creation, activities, and cessation of the Museum Junior Council (1940-1942). Most of the letters and materials come from various Museum employees, who mailed the items to Baird. Some of the letters describe the roles of the Museum Junior Council, which included making exhibitions and providing program opportunities to the Museum's visitors. Baird held various roles on the Museum Junior Council from Acting Curator of Insects to Head of Exhibits Department. Lastly, the notebook contains materials related to Baird's other Museum involvements from the loan kits, various clubs, invitations to Museum holiday parties, and work schedules for different programs and events.

Arrangement: Materials within the notebook are kept in original order.
