Abstract: The Board of Trustees Collection includes materials from the early founding of the Museum, including leases and bylaws, as well as meeting minutes, correspondence, and reports from the founding to the present.

Conditions Governing Reproduction and Use: Copyright belongs to Boston Children's Museum. All requests for permission to publish or quote for publication must be submitted in writing to the Archives. Permission for publication is given on behalf of Boston Children's Museum as the owner of the physical items and as the owner of copyright in items.

Acquisition Information

Provenance/Custodial History: The majority of the Board of Trustees Collection materials were found during the 2017 inventory of the 2006 Centennial Collection. It is unknown where the materials were located pre-2006.

Accruals: Accruals are expected annually for the Board of Trustees Collection.

Background Information

Organizational Note: Founded in 1913 by the Science Teachers' Bureau, Boston Children's Museum serves children, families, and educators, as a nonprofit educational institution. In its earliest years, the Museum provided resources for teachers and students, as a center for the exchange of materials and ideas to advance the teaching of science. Throughout the years and to the present day, the Museum's exhibitions focus on science, culture, environmental awareness, health & fitness, and the arts. In addition to exhibitions, Museum educators develop numerous programs and activities that address literacy, performing arts, science and math, visual arts, cultures, and health and wellness. The Museum is also one of the few children's museums in the world to maintain a collection. The Museum's collections of Americana, Natural History, Global Culture, Native American, Dolls and Dollhouses, and Japanese artifacts encompass more than 50,000 items.

Collection Information

Scope and Content: The Board of Trustees Collection contains founding records (such as the address given at the opening, the prospectus of the Science Teachers' Bureau, and the bylaws and constitution) as well as correspondence, meeting minutes from various committees (including building, executive, and governance), and official reports up to the present. Included are photographs with given captions and context.

Archivists Note: This collection was accessioned in October 2018 and separated from the 2006 Centennial Collection materials. This collection has no known original order, as the Board of Trustee materials were previously pulled from unknown records boxes that were either stored at the Museum or also at the offsite Iron Mountain storage. After an inventory of pulled Centennial materials, the Board of Trustees records were pulled and placed together to form the Board of Trustees Collection.
