Abstract: This collection consists of materials created by and related to the now dissolved Kits Department at the Boston Children's Museum. The department developed over 300 kits on topics ranging from history to geography to natural science which were sent to schools to augment curriculums or introduce students to new concepts. The collection includes correspondence and internal memos related to the development of both the program and individual kits, promotional materials (including catalogues with descriptions of the program and individual kits), and materials from the kits as they were circulated to schools.

Acquisition Information

Provenance/Custodial History: The records in the Kits Collection were found during the 2017 inventory of the 2006 Centennial Collection. It is unknown where the materials were located pre-2006.

Accruals: No accruals are expected.

Background Information

Historical Note: The Kits Department and Program at the Boston Children’s Museum began in 1938 as a way to circulate collections materials and corresponding descriptive labels to local schools, youth groups, and Boston Children’s Hospital. Beginning in 1963 this program expanded to include the MATCH Box Kits program-- multimedia kits containing books, videos, games, and activities aimed at elementary school aged children, which could be rented out for one to three weeks, covering a broad range of topics. The program’s name was taken from what its creators considered to be its primary purpose—to serve as Material Aids for Teaching Children—and was designed with the aim of providing teaching aids to educators and engaging ways of learning to students. In the following decades more kit programs and units were developed, each with unique subjects and teaching goals but all with a focus on facilitating experiential learning in the classroom, introducing students to wide ranges of unfamiliar topics, and bolstering pre-existing school curriculums. The Kits Department officially closed down in 2010, although the collection contains some thank you notes from students and teachers that are dated from 2011.

Collection Information

Scope and Content: This collection contains material covering the development of the Kit Program as well as specific kits. This includes internal correspondence, notes, and drafts regarding the program and kits, draft grant proposals, correspondence with schools and teachers, evaluation forms, and statistics on rental rates for kits along with reports on conservation and safety concerns regarding the materials being circulated in kits. The collection also includes kit catalogs ranging from 1965 to 2003 and press releases on new kits. The development of the MATCH Box Kit Program is significantly represented, including initial project and funding proposals, bi-monthly progress reports, and several rounds of drafts and notes on the program, its teaching goals, and the individual kits being developed. The bulk of the collection is comprised of materials used in kits as they were rented by schools. This includes kit guides describing the contents of the kit with suggested activities, any additional material included in the kit created by the Museum, and packing instructions.

Arrangement: The collection has been divided into two series: Development and Kit Materials. The Development series has been further divided into three subseries: General Kit Development, Program Development, and Promotion. General Kit Development contains material relating to the creation and maintenance of kits, Program Development contains material relating to the Kit Program, and Promotion documents materials circulated publically to advertise the Kit Program as well as correspondence with schools, teachers, and students. Any documentation relating to the development of specific kits is included in the Kit Materials series, along with finalized kit guides and material included in kits. In keeping with the organizational system used for most of the material, both series have been arranged alphabetically. Three boxes of oversized material have been removed from the Program Development Subseries and are listed at the end of the finding aid.
